

## MLB 25 CLUB Rules

25 Square Pool. 25 Players for the season. Pick one square that is yours for the season. The remaining 75 squares stay blank. The Sunday night game is the one used for the club, unless there is not one scheduled. In this case, the Pool Manager will determine which game will be used. Numbers will be drawn on the preceding Monday night.

The 25 Club will be 675 points for the season. The club is 27 weeks long, which includes the 27 weeks of regular season play only. Each week, 625 points will be used for the weekly distribution or carried over to the next week if no one wins that week.

FINAL SCORE – 625 points

For any games that are postponed or delayed to a later date, points will be carried over to the Sunday of the following week. MLB rules will be used to determine if a game is considered to be official. If the postponed game is the last game of the season, the Pool Manager will determine which game will be used.

If a square comes up that is blank the points are carried over to the next week. All blank squares are carried this way until the final game of the season. If a blank square comes up for the final score of the final game of the season, then the closest square vertical and/or horizontal wins the points. If there is a tie, the points will be equally divided to the winners.
