



2018 NCAA Men's Basketball Sweet 16 Square Pool

- There is a 100 square grid, each square will be 100. For a total of 10,000.
- After all the squares have been completely sold, the numbers will be randomly drawn.
- The same numbers will be used for ALL 15 GAMES starting with the Sweet 16!
- The Sweet 16 starts on Thursday, March 22nd and ends on Monday, April 2.
- The last digits of the final score of each game will be used to determine the winning squares (Example Temple 54 Duke 68 Winning square is Temple 4 Duke 8.)
- This format makes it possible to win multiple games with the same numbers.

Payouts will increase with each round of the tournament – see below:

Round	Payout	Number of Games	Total Payout
Regional Semifinals	250 per game	8 games	2000
Regional Finals	500 per game	4 games	2000
National Semifinals	1000 per game	2 games	2000
Championship	4000 per game	1 game	4000

The numbers across the top of the grid will represent the **WINNING** teams.
 The numbers down the left of the grid will represent the **LOSING** teams.
